

Civic and State Square Revitalisation

Notice of after-hours works starting 25 July 2024

Works continue on the Northern Territory Art Gallery.

Construction company Sitzler Pty Ltd is continuing a series of concrete pours at the site, now forming the floor of the art gallery. To date, over 3105 cubic metres of concrete has been poured during construction.

These large pours need to occur prior to the project's standard hours of work, which are 7am – 6pm Monday to Friday and 7am – 1pm on Saturdays, as lower ambient temperatures are better for curing the concrete. The rate of curing as the concrete sets effects the workability and strength of the concrete slab.

A slab pour for the suspended ground floor is planned to start on **25 July, 2024 from 3:30 am**. The concrete pour may be delayed to later that evening or in the following days if required.

There are an additional 10 large concrete pours that will occur outside of the standard hours of work over the next 12 months.

The contractor will provide notice of these pours and will endeavour to reduce dust and noise impacts to stakeholders during these times.

Access and parking conditions

Current traffic access and parking conditions remain in place, including the closure of the driveway access to the Supreme Court, Parliament House and Old Town Hall Ruins off Smith Street.

Access is available to the Supreme Court for deliveries/short term only parking via Bennett Street. Please exercise caution while driving and walking in the area during this busy period.
