

Mandorah marine facilities upgrade

Notice of night works starting

New marine facilities are being constructed at Mandorah to improve and maintain public transport services for residents and visitors to Mandorah, Wagait Beach and Belyuen.

The new facilities include a new boat ramp, toilet facilities, car park upgrades and an improved experience for ferry users. Importantly, it will also provide better access for people with disabilities.

Construction update

Construction is being staged to enable additional dry season activities and program for the contractor.

Construction of the facility is progressing well with the southern and northern breakwaters taking shape.

In order to make use of the lower tides during the night, the contractor will be scheduling construction works within the project area according to the tidal ranges, which will include night works, starting from 22 July 2024. The timing of construction works at night will vary according to tidal movements.

Additional lighting will be erected during the night works and impacts are expected to be minimised due to the distance of the project site from the Wagait Beach town site.



Construction of the southern and northern breakwaters continues on site for the Mandorah Marine Facilities project.



Access to some sections of the Mandorah Jetty car park area may be restricted during the works and regular updates will be provided on any potential construction impacts.
