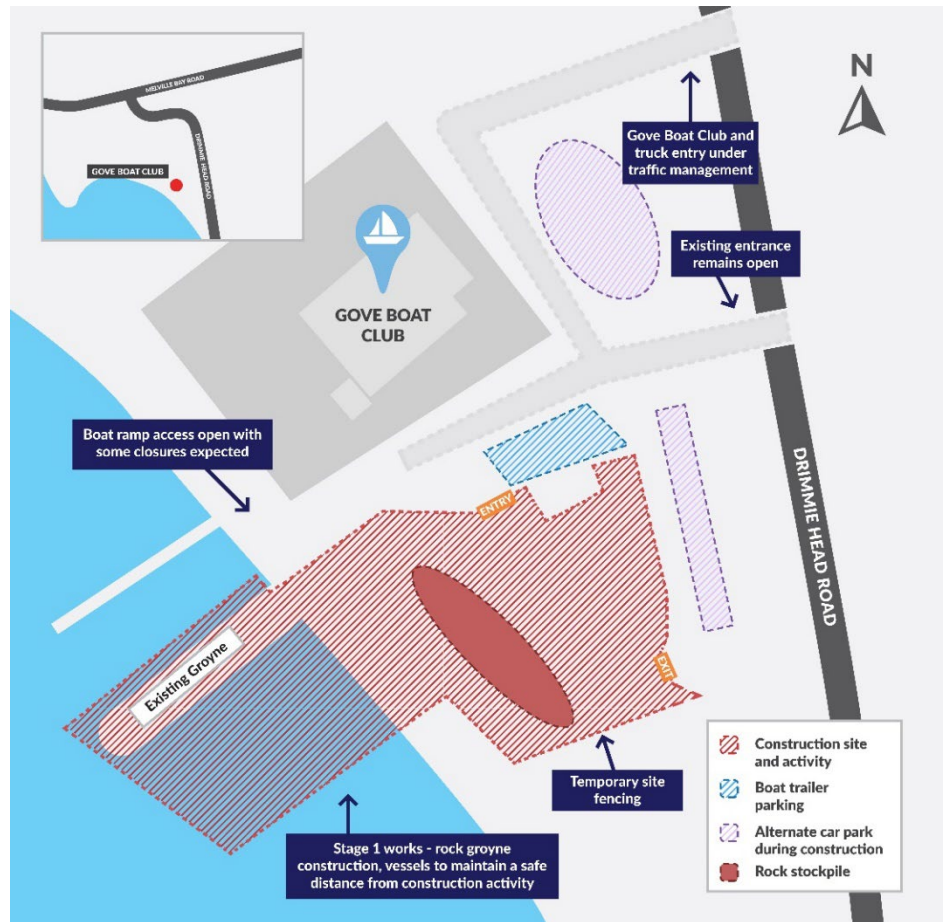
Notice of marine construction activity – November 2024

Construction is progressing on a project to extend and upgrade marine and landside facilities at Inverell Bay, Gunyangara, near Nhulunbuy.

The works include building a new extended rock groyne, careening facilities, floating pontoon extending from the groyne, washdown bay, car park upgrades and an entry structure at Gove Boat Club.

Access and car parking changes shown in the map (right) include:

- alternate car parking areas available for visitors and users
- entry to the Gove Boat Club and Manyimi Campground will remain open
- truck movements will be under traffic management.



Marine traffic

An excavator and front end loader will be working on the existing groyne at the Gove Boat Club to build and extend the new groyne over the next two months.

Vessels are required to maintain a safe distance from the construction area while the excavator is in operation.

A marine spotter will be stationed on the foreshore to notify vessels to maintain a safe distance from the construction equipment while it is operating. The marine spotter and excavator operator are contactable via **VHF Channel 16** if required.

The boat ramp will remain open during the initial stages of construction, with boat ramp closures required when construction progresses. The project team will provide notifications prior to the boat ramp being closed.
