

Mandorah Marine Facilities

New facilities open on 16 August 2025



The new Mandorah Marine Facilities will open to the public on Saturday, 16 August 2025.

The new ferry terminal, ferry pontoon, car park, boat trailer park and boat ramp will be open for use.

SeaLink will start operating its ferry service from the new ferry pontoon from Saturday morning and all ferry passengers will need to use the ferry pontoon to get on and off the ferry.

The Mandorah Jetty will no longer be used for ferry services to and from Darwin.

The new *Disability Discrimination Act 1992* compliant facilities provides access improvements for people with disability and people who need mobility assistance, including wheelchairs and prams.

As the marine infrastructure project transitions into an operational phase it enters a defects liability period for this custom designed and manufactured marine infrastructure. The facility will be monitored and if necessary, adjusted during this period.

Ferry vessels

Recreational boat users need to be aware that the ferry has right of way when entering and exiting the new marina.

When the ferry is entering the marina, vessels should stop and wait for the ferry to dock alongside the pontoon before continuing on.

When the ferry is leaving the marina, vessels should wait for the ferry to clear the channel markers before continuing on.

Recreational boats

When entering and exiting the new marina and entrance channel, recreational boat users must:

- keep as near to the right side as safely as possible
- pass other recreational boats on the vessels' port sides.

A 5 knot speed limit applies inside the marina.

There is no public mooring on the ferry pontoon.

Boat ramp

The boat ramp is estimated to be accessible at a low tide of 2.5 metres depending on the size of the boat. Boat owners should make their own assessment before launching at low tides.
