

Mandorah Marine Facilities Project

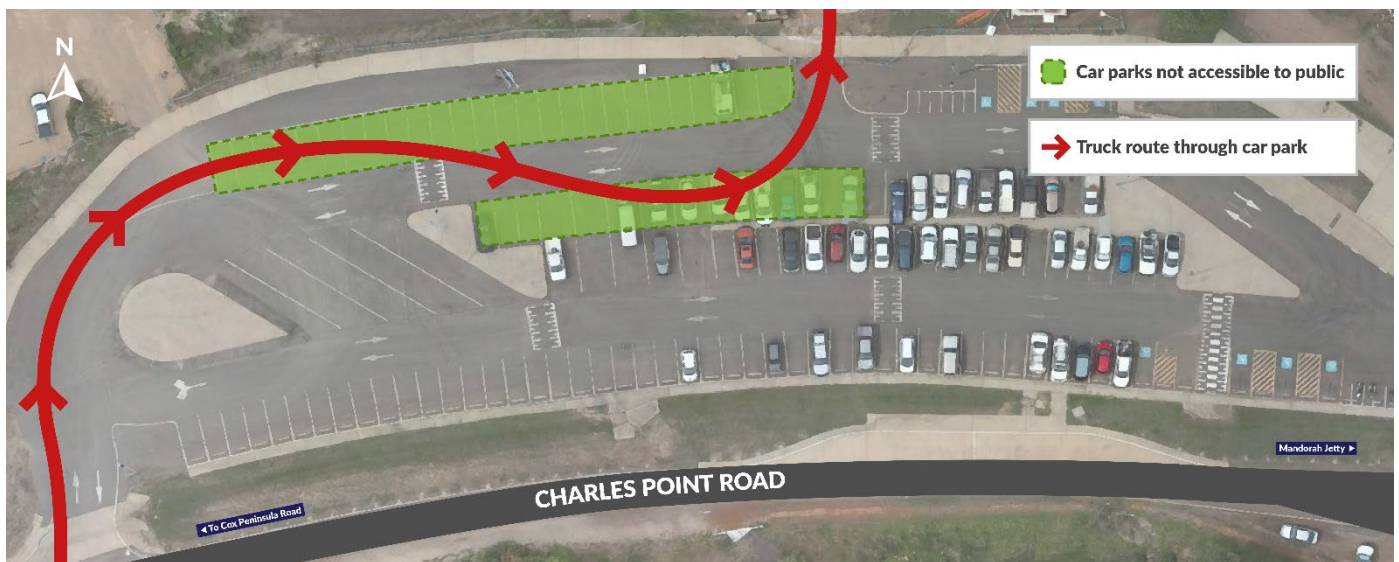
Change to car park access – 5 & 6 December

The Northern Territory Government is delivering new marine facilities to improve and maintain public transport services for residents and visitors to Mandorah, Wagait Beach and Belyuen.

Construction is continuing on the new access road and car parks for the new marine facilities and trucks will be delivering pavement to the construction site over two days on **5 and 6 December 2024**.

To enable the trucks to enter the construction site safely, a number of car parks in the Mandorah Jetty car park will be cordoned off and unavailable for public use during this two day period.

People are asked to follow any traffic control measures in place during this time.
