

Gunyangara (Gove Port) Tourism Precinct

Notice of boat ramp closure – 19 - 20 November 2024

Construction is progressing on a project to extend and upgrade marine and landside facilities at Inverell Bay, Gunyangara, near Nhulunbuy.

The works include building a new extended rock groyne, careening facilities, floating pontoon extending from the groyne, washdown bay, car park upgrades and an entry structure at Gove Boat Club.

Vessels are required to maintain a safe distance from the construction area while the excavator is in operation.

A marine spotter will be stationed on the foreshore to notify vessels to maintain a safe distance from the construction equipment while it is operating.

The marine spotter and excavator operator are contactable via VHF Channel 16 if required.

Boat ramp closure

To facilitate works on the northern side of the rock groyne, the Gove Boat Club boat ramp will be closed during the following times with no public access:
