

# Mandorah new marine facilities

## Project update – February 2023

- The Northern Territory Government is delivering safer and more accessible new marine facilities at Mandorah to service ferry passengers travelling between Darwin and the Cox Peninsula.
- A tender opportunity to deliver the project is currently at market.
- The tender period has been extended to allow potential contractors to price design and construction aspects of the project separately, to encourage the best value and outcomes for the Territory in the delivery of the project. Tender periods may be extended due to factors including addressing technical and contractual matters and allowing tenderers more time to respond.
- Contract award is targeted for mid 2023, with construction to start soon afterwards.
- A contract for early works at the site of the new facilities at Mandorah has been awarded to local company Quality Constructions and Maintenance, and site works are expected to commence in February 2023.
- The early works contract includes clean-up and preparation works on an existing building beside the jetty carpark, and design of the new structure which will be refurbished as part of the project to provide shade and toilet facilities for ferry passengers.
