Civic and State Square Redevelopment

The Northern Territory Government is continuing to revitalise the Civic and State Square precinct into a welcoming and interactive reimagined green heart of Darwin city.

The next stages of the project include constructing the State Square Art Gallery and completing a detailed design for the remainder of the precinct ahead of construction.

The remainder of the precinct will include:

- constructing an iconic and contemporary art gallery
- an inviting and interactive central heart
- sheltered pedestrian walkways connecting the precinct and surrounding areas
- Aboriginal artwork to celebrate our city's rich cultural history
- wayfinding
- lush shading and landscaping
- water features.

Delivery of the precinct began in 2019 and a number of projects have been completed or are underway:

- demolition and greening of the Chan Building site
- completion of the State Square underground car park
- revitalising the space on top of the car park into a tropical oasis
- completion of the redevelopment of the former 90 bay Parliamentary car park to create public parkland and festival lawns
- completion of the State Square Art Gallery detailed design
- Liberty Square design in Q2 2022 and construction late 2022.

The planning process and history of the precinct

A comprehensive masterplan was developed in 2018-19 to guide the revitalised precinct. The planning process included extensive consultation with stakeholders and the community to incorporate the public's vision into the area.

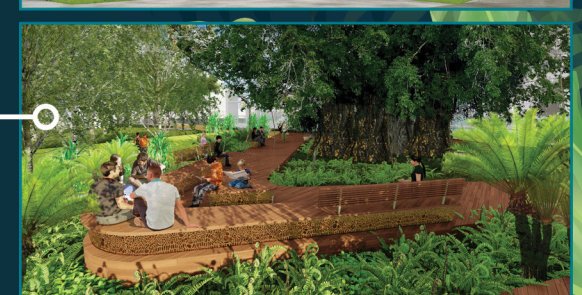
Civic and State Square is a place of significance, as both a place of work for our democracy and civil society and as a space that belongs to the public. As Larrakia land, its heritage has evolved and functioned for many different purposes and continues to host a variety of buildings, monuments, artefacts and meaning. Preserving the heritage and historic aspects of the precinct have been an important consideration in the planning process and are at the forefront of the design.
