

Civic and State Square Revitalisation

Notice of after-hours work starting 11 December 2023

Work is continuing to build the Northern Territory Art Gallery as part of the Civic and State Square Revitalisation project in the centre of Darwin.

The revitalisation forms part of the Territory Government's Darwin City Deal, delivered in partnership with the Australian Government and the City of Darwin, and will transform the precinct into a welcoming and interactive central gathering place in the CBD.

Construction company Sitzler Pty Ltd are starting the first of a series of large concrete pours.



The concrete pours need to occur outside of the project's standard hours of work, which are 7 am – 6 pm Monday to Friday and 7 am – 1 pm on Saturdays.

A 160 cubic metre concrete slab pour for the basement is planned to start on 11 December 2023 from 5 am, weather permitting.

Approximately 17 large concrete pours are planned to occur outside of the standard hours of work over the next 12 months. The contractor will provide notice of these pours and will reduce dust and noise impacts to stakeholders during these times.

Access and parking conditions

Current traffic access and parking conditions remain in place, including the closure of the driveway access to the Supreme Court, Parliament House and Old Town Hall Ruins off Smith Street. Access is available to the Supreme Court for deliveries/short term parking via Bennett Street with left turn in and left turn out.
