

Civic and State Square Revitalisation

Notice of after-hours works starting 25 June 2024

Works continue in 2024 to build the Northern Territory Art Gallery. Construction company Sitzler Pty Ltd is continuing a series of concrete pours at the site, now forming the ground floor of the Gallery. Over 2800 cubic metres of concrete has been poured so far during construction.

These large concrete pours need to occur prior to the project's standard hours of work, which are 7am – 6pm Monday to Friday and 7am – 1pm on Saturdays, as lower ambient temperatures are required to set the concrete.

The concrete slab pour for the ground floor is planned to start on **25 June 2024 from 4.30 am**. The pour may be delayed to later that evening or in the following days if required.

There are an additional 12 large concrete pours that will occur outside of the standard hours of work over the next 12 months.

The contractor will provide notice of these pours and will endeavour to reduce dust and noise impacts to stakeholders during these times.

Access and parking conditions

Current traffic access and parking conditions remain in place, including the closure of the driveway access to the Supreme Court, Parliament House and Old Town Hall Ruins off Smith Street.

Access is available to the Supreme Court for deliveries/short term only parking via Bennett Street. Please exercise caution while driving and walking in the area during this busy period.
